It's just a little early this year: As Easter falls on March 31, that means Ash Wednesday will be February 14. (If you're giving up sweets for Lent, you might consider celebrating Valentine's Day a little early!)

All Souls' will offer a full program of Lenten activities again this year:

- **Shrove (or Fat) Tuesday**, February 13, 6:00 PM
Our annual pancake supper ... pancake races ... fellowship and general shenanigans for all ... concluding with the burial of the ALLELUIA and burning of the palms, in the Columbarium
- **Ash Wednesday**, February 14
A said service at 12:00 PM and a service with music at 7:00 PM, both with the imposition of ashes
- **Lenten Wednesday Evenings**, February 21 – March 20
 - Evening Prayer, 5:30 PM
 - Simple soup supper, 6:00 PM
 - Movie discussion, 6:30 PM ~ This year, instead of reading a book, we'll pre-watch some excellent films (like *Places in the Heart*, *Castaway* and *Babette's Feast*, to name a few), at home ... and then, after supper, discuss the thoughts and themes—faith, discipleship, doubt, sacrifice—they may evoke, led by Fr Douglas and Bp Mathes

I invite you to deepen your spiritual journey this Lent by joining us as we prepare ourselves, body and spirit, for the bittersweet of Holy Week and the glory of Easter.
