Sept 26: Family-friendly Feast of St Michael and All Angels

This feast is one of the most fun of the whole year: Who doesn't like angels?!? On **Saturday, September 26, at 5:00 pm**, we'll have a **family-friendly Eucharist**—like the one we had in January, for the Epiphany—to celebrate St Michael and all his heavenly colleagues: a simple liturgy of readings and songs ... with activities for the children after each reading (rumor has it that wings, halos, lions, shields and/or megaphones may all be used!) ... Holy Communion with the children gathered round the Altar ... and afterwards, a special 'angelic feast' in Gooden Hall, with games and good times. Plan to bring your children, grandchildren, neighbors' children (with permission, of course!)... or just your child-at-heart—for this service is open to *everyone* who likes angels!

September 27: Special Speaker on Healthcare for Seniors

During this spring's parish survey, over 60 parishioners responded with topics of interest, and issues related to seniors were one of the leading topics. In a few weeks, All Souls' will have the pleasure of hearing Michael McHale, President and CEO of St. Paul's Senior Services present "Issues and Solutions in Senior Healthcare." (Michael preached at All Souls' in August.) His talk will be on Sunday, September 27, at 9:15 in the Sherman Room, and will include time for discussion. October 04: St Francis Day

As per our custom, on the first Sunday of October, we'll celebrate St Francis of Assisi again this year. Your **animals are welcome to join us at both services** ... and we'll have our annual **Community Blessing of the Animals** after the 10:15 Eucharist. (You might want to tell friends and neighbors to come at around 11:35 or so if they're not coming to church with you.) And at 3:00 pm, in the Chapel, we'll offer a quiet **Remembrance of Lost Pets**, with a little reception to follow.

Can You Help Provide a Monthly Meal at Rachel's Night Shelter?

Rachel's Women's Center, in East Village in downtown San Diego, is a drop-in and overnight shelter for women experiencing homelessness. For decades, Catholic Charities of the Diocese of San Diego, with the support of community partners like All Souls', has provided a safe and supportive environment at the Center, with opportunities for women with few or no resources to begin and continue self help efforts.

For several years now, All Souls' parishioners and friends have been providing a home cooked meal one evening a month for the 35 overnight guests at Rachel's Night Shelter. Since there are no cooking facilities at the Center, all meals are brought in. Our volunteers plan each meal, cook at home and deliver and serve the meal. Through their presence and service, they continue to help build community.

We'd like to expand our All Souls' ministry to provide a *second* monthly dinner meal at Rachel's Night Shelter. In order to do this, we need **five more volunteers**. Both men and women are invited to participate. Please contact Maria Piña for further information.
