An Exploration of the Nicene Creed through Hymns and Readings, with renowned organist and director Bruce Neswick.

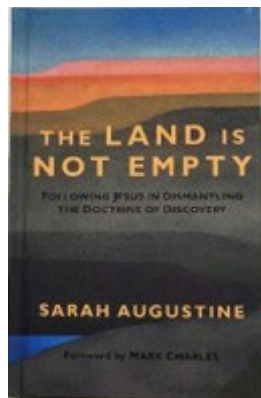
Don't miss an opportunity to sing many of your favorite hymns led by Dr. Bruce Neswick on All

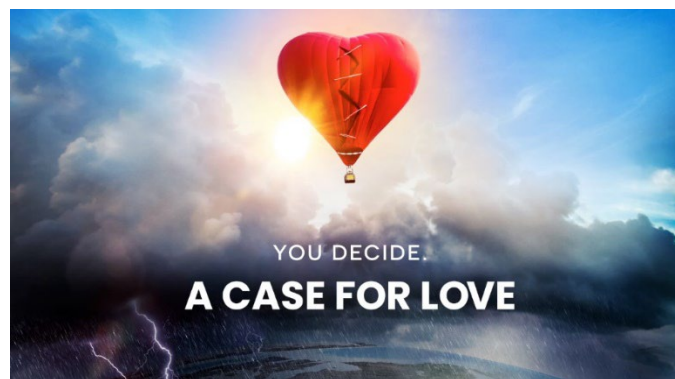
1) LARK (Localized Anti-Racism Knowledge)
